### Intent to Publish: Notification of USDAR

Any written work intended for presentation at specialty meetings (slides, posters, oral abstracts) or publication in peer-reviewed journals will be reviewed by the USDAR Committee. Any material should be submitted to the USDAR committee at least 30 days prior to the submission date. These documents can be submitted via email to [xxxx@xxxxxx.xxx](mailto:xxxx@xxxxxx.xxx). The USDAR committee reserves the right to suggest edits in any materials prior to presentation/submission and to request final review of suggested edits prior to presentation/submission.

### USDAR Acknowledgment

When USDAR data are presented in any manner (slides, posters, oral abstracts, publication in peer reviewed journals), the USDAR respectfully requests citation with the following:

*The United States Drug Allergy Registry (USDAR) is a drug allergy data consortium between Massachusetts General Hospital, Rochester Regional Health, University of Texas Southwestern, and Vanderbilt University. It is supported through the MGH Claflin Distinguished Scholar Award.*

### Authorship

USDAR requires offer of authorship to any enrolling USDAR investigator meaningfully contributing patients used in the dataset addressing a specific research question. We will evaluate contribution based on volume, consistency, and diversity of patients enrolled. If the offer of authorship is accepted, these investigators must contribute to the work in other ways to qualify for authorship. USDAR follows guidelines for authorship at Harvard Medical School, available at:
